<b>1. Cortese Araladica Piedmonte 2007, Italy</b> <i>Fresh, primary fruit aromas of ripe grapefruit with citrus notes; zingy, juicy and crisp with lemon flavours and mineral touches, it finishes with gently zesty acidity.</i>	<b>3.25</b>	<b>13.00</b>
<b>2. Sauvignon Blanc Sierra Grande 2007, Chile</b> <i>Full of tingling aromatics, typical of it's grape variety, this wine is bursting with exotic tropical fruit flavours, yet retains freshness through it's natural racy acidity.</i>	<b>3.50</b>	<b>14.00</b>
<b>3. Rioja Blanco Viura Artesa 2007</b> <i>Clean, fresh and attractive nose showing hints of ripe peach and pear. Ripe, round and almost creamy palate cut through with a refreshing streak of zesty acidity.</i>		<b>14.50</b>
<b>4. Chenin Blanc Somerbosch 2007, South Africa</b> <i>Elegant white. An un-wooded wine that has a full rich stone fruit – almost apricot character. A beautiful aperitif or savour with chicken or grilled fish.</i>	<b>4.00</b>	<b>16.00</b>
<b>5. Unoaked Chardonnay Crystal Brook 2007, Australia</b> <i>Fresh melon, peach and pineapple aromas on the nose whilst the palate is clean and rich with complex fruit flavours mingled with notes of butterscotch.</i>		<b>17.00</b>
<b>6. Pinot Grigio Conviviale 2007, Italy</b> <i>Top quality Pinot. A crisp and lively dry white, lightly aromatic with characters of peach and citrus fruits on the nose. Medium bodied with fresh lemony fruit and underlying hints of nuts and a gently honeyed finish.</i>	<b>4.25</b>	<b>17.00</b>
<b>7. Gros Manseng Domaine de Maubet Coup de Coeur 2006</b> <i>Aromatic with hints of grapefruit, citrus peel and honey, it's quite rich and round with sweet and sour tangy finish.; in the end well balanced so tastes more towards off/medium dry. Nice with fruit salad including strawberries or melon but also good with liver pate and stronger cheeses.</i>		<b>19.00</b>
<b>8. Gavi de Gavi Nuovo Quadro Azienda Agricola La Battistina 2007, Italy</b> <i>An enticing nose of white peach and acacia blossoms with just a hint of crystallised ginger. Fresh and light zesty citrus notes on the palate lift a textured well rounded mouthfeel.</i>		
<b>9. Sauvignon Blanc The Crossing 2007, Marlborough New Zealand</b> <i>Powerful aromas of lime, passionfruit and herbal notes. The palate is complex with melon and stone fruit underpinned by zesty acidity and a flinty minerality..</i>		<b>22.50</b>

<b>12. Pink Shiraz The Lizard 2007, France</b> <i>Red fruit flavours and a lip smacking-dry finish. Enjoy with salmon and summer salads.</i>	<b>3.75</b>	<b>14.50</b>
<b>13. Cabernet Syrah Rose Estampa 2007, Chile</b> <i>A bouquet of red berries and fresh fruits like cherries and white peaches with hints of almond notes and flower petals. <b>14. Garnacha Borsao 2007, Spain</b> <i>Juicy brambly fruit and fresh redcurrants dominate this generous easy drinking wine. Soft tannins, good acidity and hint of spiciness make an extremely approachable wine.</i>	<b>3.50</b>	<b>14.00</b>
<b>15. Merlot Domaine de Bahourat Vins de Pays du Gard 2007, France</b> <i>Full and juicy with almost minty dark chocolate notes on top of ripe, sweet warm berry fruit. Seriously good without being too serious!</i>	<b>3.75</b>	<b>14.50</b>
<b>16. Syrah/Cabernet Estampa 2006, Chile</b> <i>Rich blackberry fruits with hints of cinnamon and cherry. Very smooth and very easy drinking.</i>	<b>3.75</b>	<b>14.50</b>
<b>17. Rioja Tempranillo Vega del Rayo 2007, Spain</b> <i>A modern, vibrant, unoaked tempranillo. Oozing with red fruits, fresh cherries and plums with hints of spicy complexity. Soft and easy to drink with approachable ripe fruit yet well-structured.</i>	<b>4.00</b>	<b>15.50</b>
<b>18. Salice Salentino Vallone 2003, Italy</b> <i>Warm, rich and velvety with a mere hint of the bitterness typical of Negro Amaro. On the palate the wine is ripe and meaty with sweet, raisiny, cooked black fruit flavours. A soft, dry finish completes this perfectly balanced wine.</i>		<b>18.50</b>
<b>20. Shiraz Norfolk Rise 2005, Australia</b> <i>A fine example of cool climate Australian Shiraz with dried fruits with raisin black currant and dark cherries lightly dusted with clove and white pepper spice. A hint of aniseed and dark chocolate lingers in the glass. The wine finished with a lush concentrated mid palate and fine chalky tannins.</i>		<b>21.00</b>
<b>21. Rioja Ondarre Graciano 2004, Spain</b> <i>The typicity of this grape can be identified in the characteristic balsamic aromas of mint or aniseed, accompanied by ripe fruit and hints of flower blossom, completed with toffee and coffee nuances coming through. The palate shows richness with balanced vanilla oak. Delicious.</i>		<b>23.50</b>
<b>23. Minervois Conte des Garrigues Domaine la Prade Mari 2004, France</b> <i>Strong and elegant with soft tannins. On the palate fruit and floral flavours complemented by hints of spice and vanilla. Ideal with a diverse range of dishes from steak to moroccan food and steak to chocolate cake!</i>		<b>26.50</b>
<b>24. Chianti Classico San Jacopo da Vicchiomaggio 2005, Italy</b> <i>A ripe and fruity wine with black cherry flavours and a soft touch of silky tannins. Full of fruit with a hint of spice. Delicious!</i>		<b>27.50</b>
